**DAY 1 [Wed 12 September 2018]: Arrive Hanoi[Guide/D]**

**Noi Bai airport - Hanoi (38km): 1 hour**



Upon arrival at Hanoi's Noi Bai International Airport, you will be greeted by your guide and transferred to your hotel. This is Vietnam's capital and celebrated its anniversary of 1,000 years in 2010.

Historical emphasis on the arts and learning stipulates that buildings in Hanoi remain small, simple and in harmony with nature. You will have the afternoon at your leisure before an evening welcome dinner at a local restaurant and an overnight stay in Hanoi.

**DAY 2 [Thu 13 September 2018]: Hanoi City Tour – Water Puppet – Foodie Walking Tour [Guide/B/L/D]**

Welcome drink - receive cruise briefing, safety instructions and check in. Start cruising and explore Halong Bay - one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature. Visiting Tung Sau area, is covered by the leaping rocks, cultured pearl fishery. You can wit



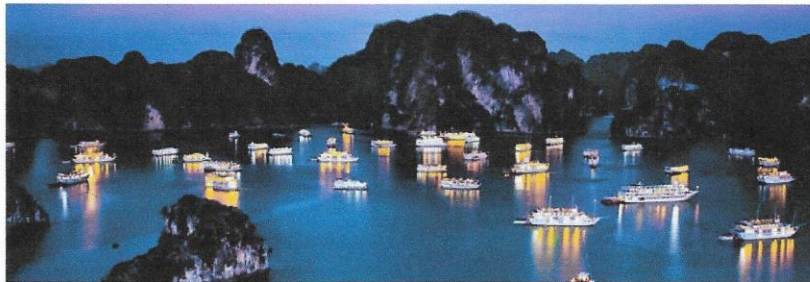

***Halong - Hanoi (183km): 3h30***

***Hanoi - Hue (700km): 1h10 by plane***



06.00 – 08.00 The day starts early onboard with Tai Chi session on the sundeck. Tai chi also called Tai chi chuan, combines deep breathing and relaxation with slow and gentle movements. Coffee, tea and pastries for breakfast are served in the dining room with morning view of bay's landscape.

08.00 – 11.30 Transfer by tender to Sung Sot Cave. Walk up about 100 steps to the cave entrance. It takes approximately 45 minutes for cave visiting. Visit Sung Sot Cave, one of the most biggest cave in Halong bay with beautiful stalactites and stalagmites. Return to the boat by tender. Proper shoes are highly recommended.



12.00 – 17.00 Back to Pelican Halong Cruise. Check out and settle your bill at reception.

Have a buffet brunch while cruising back to the Tuan Chau Wharf. Relaxing on the sundeck or in the dining room enjoying the bay scenery while approaching the wharf. Disembark to Tuan Chau Wharf. Say goodbye to the crew. Driver ahead to Hanoi's airport by private car to take a short flight to Hue.

You will also visit the Imperial Museum, Tu Hieu Pagoda and the vibrant Dong Ba Riverside market. To round off the day's activities, you will visit one of Hue's fine restaurants to sample some of its local delicacies, as Hue is regarded by many as the culinary capital of Vietnam.

**DAY 6 [Mon 17 September 2018]: Hue – Danang – Hoi An [Guide/B/L]**

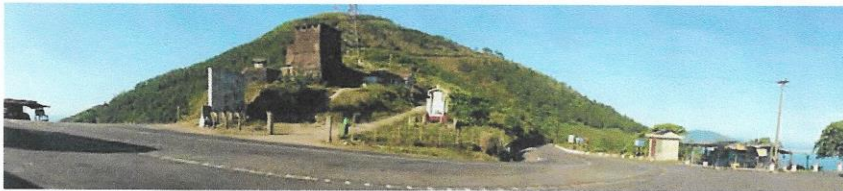
**Hue - Danang (94km): 2h10**

Rising up in the ancient land, enjoy your breakfast in the hotel. Then at **08:00 am**, board a private boat for cruising the romantic Perfume River, visit Lady Pagoda (Thien Mu Pagoda), the ornate Minh Mang's tomb. We will enjoy lunch at local restaurant at **12:30 pm**. Leave the UNESCO-designated World Heritage Hue for Hoi An.



**13:30** You will travel over the Hai Van pass, stop in Danang for a visit to the Cham Museum and handicraft villages on the foot of Marble Mountain before arriving in Hoi An. Once in Hoi An, you will check into our hotel and have some free time to explore the town before an overnight stay.

**DAY 7 [Tue 18 September 2018]: Hoi An - My Son Holy Land Excursion – Hoi An [Guide/B/L**

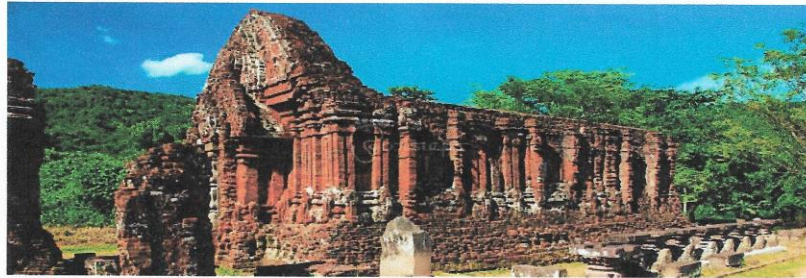


*Located 60 km. from Da Nang, 150 km. from Hue and 75km from Hoi An, My Son is the former capital of the ancient Cham civilization that ruled Central Vietnam from the second*



*to the thirteenth century, with Hindu temples and intricate religious monuments, and it's a remarkable place to learn about the unique Champa culture. Their religion was primarily derived from Indian Hinduism. My Son is considered to be one of the best-preserved Cham structures in Vietnam. The complex is comprised of seventy Hindu-like towers and temples dating from the second century. This site is a Must-See for those people who are interested in architecture and ancient civilizations and is now one of five UNESCO World Heritage sites in Vietnam.*

**Departure: 7:30 – 7:45am & Finish: 14:30pm**



Am: Our guide picks you up at hotel and leave Hoi An to board a coach for My Son Sanctuary. You'll have great views of the Hoi An river, Cham Islands, and the mountains on the 2-hour trip to My Son, with a pause to see the market at a rural fishing village.

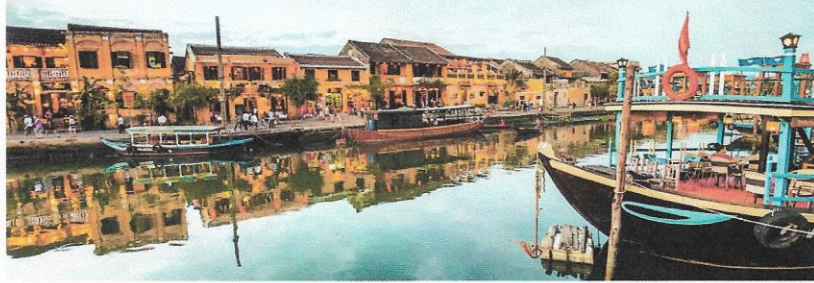
Upon arrival at My Son, the ruins of Cham people and was an imperial city during Cham dynasty. Then follow a guide into the Cham ruins, walking a short path edged with lush jungle.



Here you can have more chance to explore and understand of technique of Old Cham people in making red bricks to build Tower which still now a secret to everyone, you can see a large complex of religious relics that comprises more than 65 architectural works.

It also surprises for those who are curious with architectural art. In 1999, UNESCO labeled the Cham architecture in My Son as a World Cultural Heritage Site. You'll have two hours to explore My Son Sanctuary before the return trip to Hoi An.





At **14:00** you will enjoy a half-day walking tour through the narrow winding streets of the Ancient Quarter visiting Chua Ong Pagoda, Chinese Assembly Halls, the 200- year old Tam Ky ancestral house, and the Japanese Bridge. Following the tour there will be free time to shop or relax. You will stay overnight in Hoi An.

Ben Tre is the best option for a day trip to the Mekong Delta from Saigon, since it is only around 2 hours away, and 15 minutes from My Tho. However, this wonderful destination retains an authenticity which has been somewhat lessened in nearby My Tho.

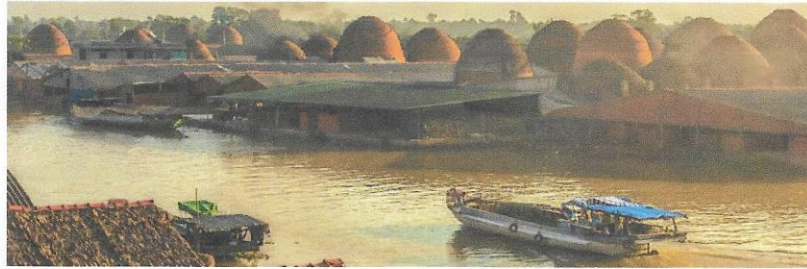
This picturesque and friendly Mekong Delta town has historically seen very few travelers, but the recent opening of a bridge connecting Ben Tre and My Tho has made it far easier for day trippers to visit from Saigon.



Our one day cruise excursion starts at **8:00 am** from the lobby of your hotel in Saigon with a drive to Ben Tre. On arrival in Ham Luong river pier.

Cruise on Bến Tre river exploring the lively activities along river as fishing, water transferring, and you'll see plenty of coconuts being unloaded from boats for dispatch around the country.

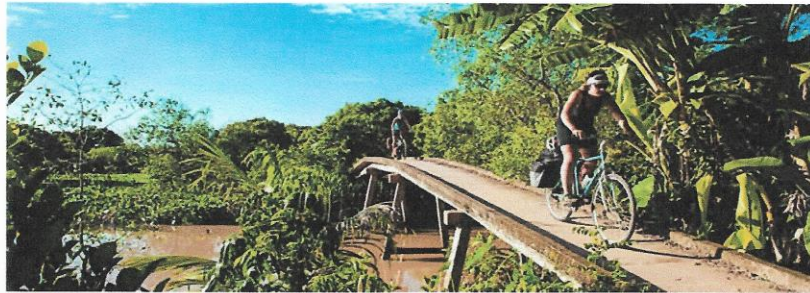




Stop to see how people make bricks making in handy traditional style by printing and baking. Then visit one of plenty of coconut processing workshops located along canal. Turn on natural scissors creeks where they look smaller and smaller to go to village.

Boat to Cai Sơn and Nhơn Thành natural scissors creeks where they look smaller and smaller to go to village. to see some family making mats and enjoying some fruits and tea.

Take bicycle on shady paths, pass by green fields and vegetable plains to know how culture in country and to be able to touch on real life and find out about tropical culture from Peasants.



**12h.30 pm** Stop at Mr. Hai Hồ for lunch. In the afternoon, take rowing-boat along water palm creek.

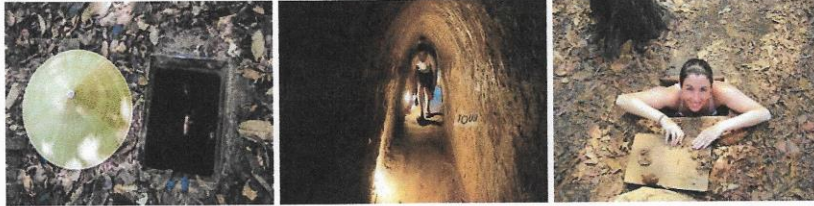
**2h.30 pm** Back to HCM city or take Cổ Chiên ferries to Tra Vinh or Cần Thơ.

**DAY 10 [Fri 21 September 2018]: Cu Chi Tunnels - Ho Chi Minh City[Guide/B/I]**

**Hoi An - Danang (29km): 45 minutes**





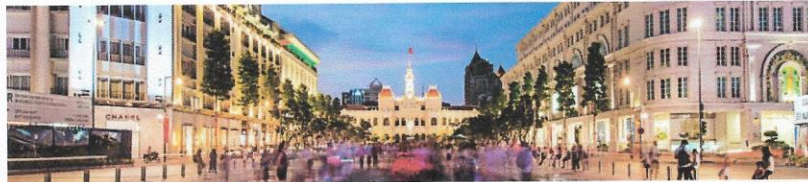
08:30 am (or 13:00) pick-up at your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City you enjoy a half day excursion to the famous Cu Chi tunnels. This network of tunnels, which stretched for over 200km, became legendary during the 1960s.

Cu Chi tunnels played a vital part in the U.S.-Vietnam War in that they allowed the Viet Cong to control a large rural area only 30 to 40 km from former Saigon .



At its height, the tunnel system stretched from Saigon to the Cambodian border. The network, parts of which were several levels deep, included innumerable trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories, field hospitals, command centres and kitchens.

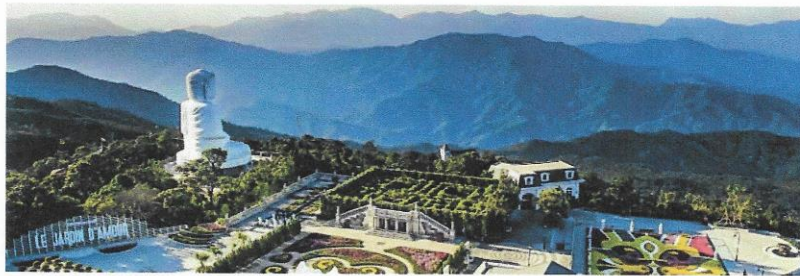
Today the remaining tunnels have become a major tourist attraction giving the visitor a unique experience and feel of what underground life during the war must have been like. The tunnels have been widened for our benefit (otherwise we would not be able to enter them!) For those interested there's even the opportunity to try an AK47 or MK16 at the nearby rifle range.



After lunch in Cu Chi, you will back to Ho Chi Minh for afternoon halfday tour. There are several interesting sights in HCMC. The **War Remnants Museum** has a wealth of images from the wars, the most moving being a gallery entitled 'Requiem' which is dedicated to



**09:45** You will admire the high by the most modern cable car system in Southeast Asia which gains 5 world scores to Ba Na hills station. You will visit Dream Stream Cable car Station.



After finishing the first cable car, you will stop at By Night station to visit Vong Nguyet hills, French old villas, Linh Ung pagoda. You will see the panorama of Danang City. Continue moving up by cable car to the Nui Chua Mountain – the top of Ba Na range, visiting Ngingh Phong top, Le Nim Villas, Orchid Garden...

Experience hill climbing train (first and unique funicular in Vietnam) and visit an old French cellar (Debay Ancient Wine Cellar), flower garden Le Jardin D’amour.



**10:15** Time for visiting Daring Bridge or play game at the Fantasy Park, – the third biggest indoor games zone in Vietnam with series of interesting games: 4 – 5D film, skiver, The death race, dinosaur park... (2 hours).

**11:30** Explore King Peak at an altitude 1.487m, you can see panorama view of the Hana Hills and Quang Nam - Da Nang on high. On the top of mountain have Linh Tu Pagoda that is a special temple construction. You will leave Ba Na Hills at **15:30** then drive ahead to Danang Airport for a flight Ho Chi Minh City.



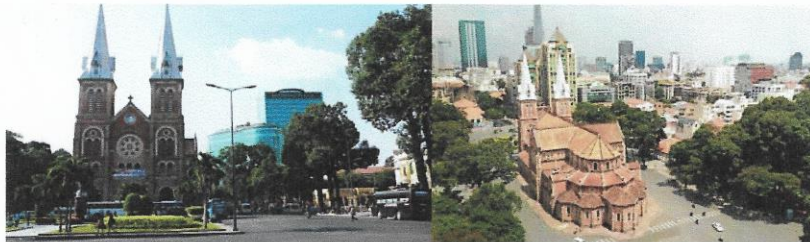

The **Reunification Palace** was the former residence of the President of South Vietnam until April 30, 1975 when the North Vietnamese tanks came crashing through the front gates, bringing the U.S.-Vietnam War to a dramatic end.

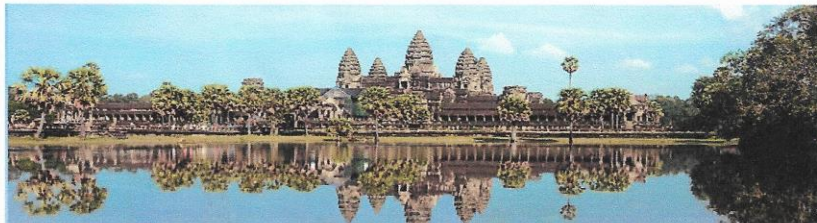
Close to the palace some of the best examples of French colonial architecture are represented in the forms of **Notre Dame Cathedral** and the **Central Post Office**.



Notre Dame Cathedral was built between 1877 and 1883 and the stone used to create it was exported in its entirety from France. Next to the cathedral stands the **Central Post Office**, finished in 1891. It is another fine example of French architecture and is Vietnam's largest post office. For all its French colonial history though, Ho Chi Minh City is by far and away Vietnam's most modern city. It has numerous shopping malls, cinemas, discotheques and a bewildering number of bars.

**DAY 11 [Sat 22 September 2018 ]: Ho Chi Minh - Fly to Seam Reap [Guide/B/L]**

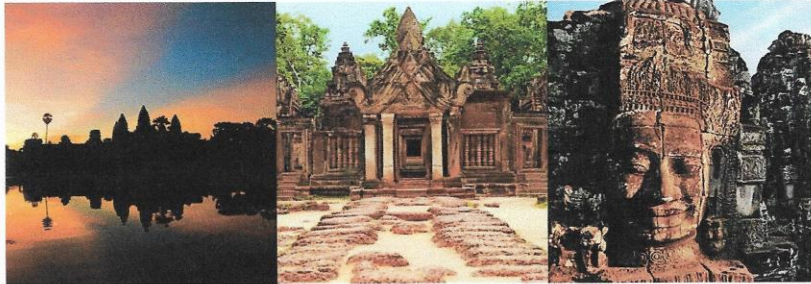


Leave Cu Chi tunnels and transfer ahead the airport of Ho Chi Minh City for a flight to Seam Reap of Cambodia, your base for visiting the fabulous ancient sites of Angkor, one of the wonders of world.

**DAY 12 [Sun 23 September 2018]: Angkor Complex Sightseeing [Guide/B/D]**



Today you visit the antique capital of Angkor Thom (12 century), the South Gate with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of the Bayon Temple, unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara, the Phimeanakas, the Royal Enclosure, the Elephants Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King.

In the afternoon visit Angkor Wat - the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor.



The temple complex covers 81 hectares, which is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture.

Then continue to view wonderful sunset from Phnom Bakheng Hills. Dinner and enjoy watching Khmer Folk of charming Apsara dance show at local restaurant.



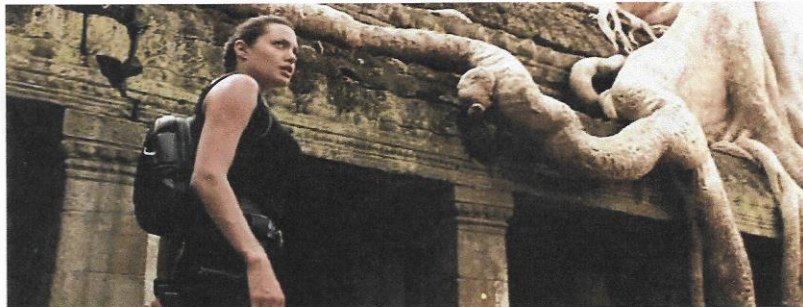

**DAY 13 [Mon 24 September 2018]: Banteay Srei - Discover Tomb Raider Temple [Guide/B]**



Visit to Banteay Srei temple (10th century), regarded as the jewel in the crown of classical Khmer Art. Then continue your visit to Banteay Samre, built in the third quarter of the 12th century. It consists of a central temple with four wings

Afternoon visit the unique interior brick sculptures of Prasat Kravan, Srah Srang ("The Royal Baths" was once used for ritual bathing), Banteay Kdei (surrounded by 4 concentric walls), Ta Keo, constructed in late 10th early 11th century C.E and Ta Prohm where Jolina Joli filmed The Tomb Raiders, one of the area's most beautiful.



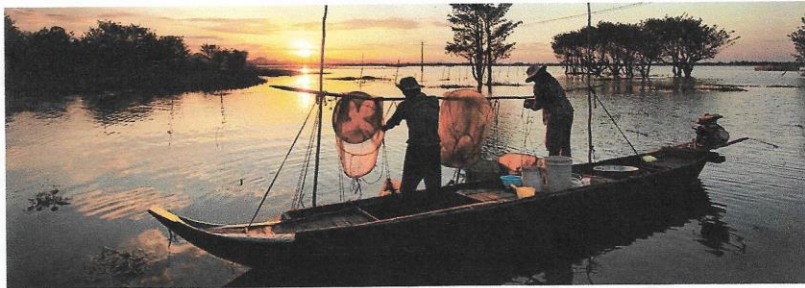
We stroll around this massive edifice, seeing the many galleries with columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple and the jungle covered temple of Ta Prohm is an incredible sight.

While Ta Prohm is the most recognized temple used as a location for the film, it is far from the only temple used.

**DAY 13 [Tue 25 September 2018]: Tonle Sap Lake – Departure [Guide/B]**
